Please send your fabric to be tested as soon as possible to be sure your garment may be eligible. All entries for MO will be sent to the lab for testing. There is now a \$5 fee per swatch in MO to cover this cost. You may have your fabric tested in advance of constructing your garment. Submit to the state director a 5" x 5" swatch of each wool fabric used in the garment(s) and the \$5 fee **per swatch**. Once your fabric passes fiber content testing at the lab, it will be certified to be used in the contest. If you have any questions, please contact the state director.

ENTERING THE CONTEST:

Entries require a \$10.00 entry fee plus \$5.00 for each fabric tested and 3 - 5" x 5" swatches of each fabric(s). Copies may be made of the entry forms. They are available at the national website - www.makeitwithwool.com 1 swatch is sent to the testing lab, the other is sent with the national form and the third is kept with the state form. (all will be sent to the state director as she sends all to the national contest)
Forms – keep the pink copy for yourself. Submit the white and yellow copies to the state director who will forward the national copy. Don't forget your entry fee and fabric swatch(s). Attach swatch(s) to the

national copy and two to the state copy.

If you have already submitted fabric for testing, you will only need to resubmit a fabric swatch for state and national. **Entries may be sewn, knit, crocheted, woven, or felted and must contain a minimum of 60% wool fibers.** A contestant may have multiple entries, but a separate entry fee and form must be submitted for each entry.

WHAT CAN I ENTER?

Juniors, Seniors, Adults

One-piece garment: dress, jumper, outerwear, jacket, coat or cape

Two-piece outfit: coat, jacket, cape, blouse/shirt, vest or sweater with dress, jumper, skirt, pants or shorts.

Ensemble (3 or more garments worn together at one time): coat, jacket, cape, blouse/shirt, vest, and/or sweater with dress, jumper skirt, pants or shorts.

HOW CAN I BE CERTAIN MY FABRICS/YARNS ARE WOOL?

- All swatches must be tested prior to contest. All swatches must be tested through the state director. The lab will not accept others.

Who Can Enter?

- Preteens, age 12 and under
- Juniors, ages 13-16
- Seniors, ages 17-24
- Adults, age 25 and over

(Ages as of December 31, 2013)

Adult Contestants

One adult contestant will be chosen as overall winner to participate in the national competition.

State Winner

The overall adult state winner will send 5 x 7 photos, a narrated video, and the garment to the National Photo Competition. One overall national adult winner is chosen to model his or her garment at the national competition.

Winners in the Junior, Senior and Adult divisions at the state level may continue to compete in the same age category. Once a participant has won first place in that age group at the national level, they are ineligible to compete until they advance to the next age group. Second place state winners may be asked to advance to national competition if the first place winner cannot attend. Preteens compete at the state level only and are eligible to compete until they reach the next age level. To be eligible, a garment must have been completed after January 1, 2013.
